Free Recycling

Recycling

- Free to residents*.
- Use any container up to 34 gallons - convert any 34 gallon barrel to recycling!
- Recycling must be visible
- Recycling is collected every week.

Waste

- Must be in tied, Yellow town bag & no more than 30 pounds
- Bags can be purchased at Lunenburg retail stores including: Hannaford's, Centre Pizza, Hadwen Park Market, MAKI & Aubuchon.



This program is FAIR. Each household's trash disposal cost is based on how much is thrown away. Households that recycle more and produce less trash pay less.
