"Walks in the Woods"

Continuing for the fourth year the Conservation Commission has scheduled site walks on town and conservation lands.

Many of the walks will be held Sunday afternoons, meeting behind the Ritter Memorial Building 1:00 PM, and should be one to two hours in duration. We hope that this will enable people to learn about where the public land is located, trails that are accessible for hiking and areas where parking is available.

Please wear suitable clothing and walking shoes, bring water and insect repellent. A hat is always a good thing to wear. All ages are welcome and well behaved dogs are also welcome to accompany the group.

July 31st ~ Robbs Hill Conservation Area

August 13th ~ PERSEIDS *METEOR SHOWER* ~ Meet at 11 PM behind the Ritter Memorial Building. 60 meters per hour. Bring blankets, insect repellent, flashlights, wear long-sleeved shirts and long pants. If cloudy or inclement weather it will be cancelled.

August 21st ~ *DAY ON THE RIVER* ~ Kayak & canoe enthusiasts (bring your own) come and enjoy an afternoon on the Nashua River. Life preservers required. Bring a picnic lunch and dress accordingly. Cancelled if raining.

September 18th ~ Pleasant Street Conservation Area ~ "Laurelbank Farm"

October 9th ~ Woodruff Farm

November 13th ~ Small Town Forest

December 13th ~ *GEMINIDS METEOR SHOWER* ~ Meet at 11 PM behind the Ritter Memorial Building. 60 meters per hour. Considered to be one of the best.
