Walks in the Woods 2016 Kick-Off

Please join us for the Lunenburg Conservation Commission's first monthly Sunday morning hike to explore the Lunenburg Conservation Lands.

We will kick off the 2016 Walks in the Woods season with the iconic Henry E. Cowdrey Nature Center. This 210-acre parcel of woods is the town-residents' most popular conservation area. It has many well maintained multi-use trails and boasts excellent views of the Mulpus Brook that runs through the center of the property.

The walk will be an easy trail hike approximately 2-3 miles long led by Tom Bertram. There are some moderate alternate hiking routes along the brook if the group is interested. We will be in the woods so bug spray and long sleeves are recommended.
