MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING

November 16, 2010

There was a large contingency of residents present. Tenants questioned why the heaters in the units were different. The Director informed the tenants that the Rinnai Company which the heaters originate from changed the model and the L/M building received the new heating models.

The Chair declared a quorum present at 7:00 p.m. and began the meeting. Minutes of the October 19, 2010 meeting were presented. On a Motion by Elizabeth Murphy, seconded by Sheila Lumi; the minutes were approved as presented. All were in favor.

The Executive Director provided his report. He gave an overview of the construction. The construction is over 80% completed. Mr. Capoccia also informed the Board that ARRA Federal Stimulus Fund will be funding the five new furnaces for the 705 units.

Mr. Capoccia then proceeded to review the Financial Report. He indicated that the Housing Authority was doing well and are ahead of the subsidy projected by \$22,301. On a motion by Sheila Lumi, seconded by Elizabeth Murphy, the Financial Report was approved, all in favor.
