Meeting called to order by the Chairman Robin Corbett at 7:10 Pm.

The minutes from 2010 were read by the secretary Mary Ann Sudolnik.

Brent Benson made a motion to accept the minutes. Caroline Griffin seconded. All were in favor.

No public comment.

The treasurer's report was presented by Jim Ryan. There is \$123.79 remaining in the Town Account. As of June 30, 2011 there was \$4306.70 to disperse to the applicants. Treasurer Jim Ryan has paid \$1,110 and has \$3,198.70 pending. The money left in Town Hall was added to the amount granted this year for a grand total of \$3993.79 to award to acceptable applicants in 2012.

Lunenburg requests amounted to \$5,173. \$6,490 was requested by groups outside Lunenburg.

Review of applications. There were 19 applications submitted. Amount requested totaled \$12,463.

The Council looked at the Lunenburg/locally sponsored requests first.

These totaled \$3857.00. Other requests totaling \$1275 were evaluated and both groups were accepted on a motion that was seconded and approved by all.

The request for "Say It with Magic" was to change the program to this coming year. It was approved by the group. The \$300 allocated last year will pay the fee this year.

A motion was made to move \$43.79 for administrative costs and was passed by all. motion was made and seconded and then passed by all present.
