The Community Preservation Act, whereby residents would contribute to a fund based on a percentage of the assessed value of their property, was discussed. This fund, with some state support, would then be able to finance various approved town projects. Amory Phelps will obtain further information about this Act and its implications.

Cullen Dwyer has been sworn in as a member of the Architectural Preservation District Commission by the Board of Selectmen. A meeting of this Commission was held January 4, 2016. Three members, as a quorum, started to consider the guidelines for this new Commission.

Richard McGrath has received only one demolition delay request, 37 Burrage Street, that requires a hearing by the Historical Commission. A special meeting was scheduled for January 25, 2016 at the Ritter Building at 6:30 p.m.

The Building Resuse Committee has scheduled a meeting for January 15, 2016 to discuss the plans for moving and consolidating all the town offices to the Passios School Building. Lois Lewis has agreed to be present at this meeting for Becky Lantry.
