Chair opened the Public Hearing with the reading of the legal notice published in the Sentinel and Enterprise on February 11 and February 18, 2013. The Hearing is to hear and discuss a modification to a special permit under Section 4.6., Subsection 4.6.4.2. of the Protective Bylaw of the Town of Lunenburg. The modification is to add three antennas and place equipment in the existing telecommunications shelter at 2005 Massachusetts Avenue. Property owner is Peter Knox, Trustee; applicant is New Cingular Wireless/ATT Mobility.

The Applicant was represented by Brian Allen, KJK Wireless, Site Acquisition Consultant. AT&T currently has six antennas mounted on a 190 foot monopole tower. The antennas are centered at 181 feet (the second grouping of antennas down from the top of the tower). AT&T wants to add three additional antennas to provide LTE (Long Term Evolution) to the community.

There are four different providers on this tower. Verizon antennas are placed slightly higher than the AT&T antennas, and Nextel and T Mobile are slightly lower.
