## Town of Lunenburg Announces American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Allocations

The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) was signed into law in 2021 and provided states and municipalities across the country with a historic opportunity to invest in their communities. Designed to address the economic and public health challenges caused by the COVID-19 pandemic and allow communities to make long-term investments in local services and infrastructure, ARPA funding enabled local governments to support essential services both during and after the public health emergency, strengthen infrastructure, improve services, and promote long-term recovery and resiliency.

The Town of Lunenburg received **\$3,507,970.58** in total from ARPA. For Lunenburg, this funding represented an unprecedented investment in public safety, education, infrastructure, and community services. Over the course of several years, the Select Board solicited proposals from Town Departments, Boards, and community organizations and carefully allocated these funds to address immediate needs caused by the COVID-19 Pandemic, while also making strategic investments that will benefit the Town long-term. From upgrading public safety equipment to supporting local non-profits, ARPA allowed the town to take on projects that would have otherwise been financially challenging.

With the December 2024 deadline for allocations now passed, the Town of Lunenburg is sharing a full breakdown of how these funds were distributed:
