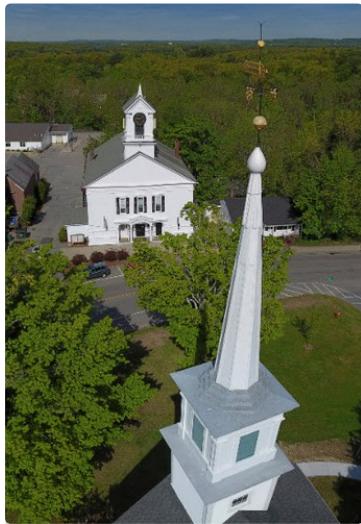

Information Session and Promotional Flyer about Community Solar

As a follow-up to our conversation about Nexamp's Community Solar available to Lunenburg residents, I spoke with Nexamp last week to discuss putting a joint promotional mailer to increase awareness about the program and they are also going to hold two informational sessions in the month of May for residents to come hear about signing up for discounted electricity. The mailer will include details about the program including that the discount is a 15% discounted rate on electricity and for the first 45 days this will only be open to Lunenburg residents.

- AT&T FirstNet Presentation: I attended a meeting today at the Dispatch Center in Devens for a presentation on FirstNet, which is a dedicated communications network tool that was created for and by public safety after 9/11. The Federal Government put out a RFP to create this network and AT&T was the only bidder and awarded the contract in 2017. Since then every State has

chosen to opt in and this is another option exclusively for public safety. Chief Sullivan and IT Director Steve Malandrinos also attended the presentation.
