REVIEW OF MINUTES:

Minutes for April 2nd, 2019, were read and approved.

CORRESPONDENCE:

The U. Mass Department of history sent notice that a training workshop would be held on June 24th in Worcester entitled "Empowering our communities through History".

Mass Historical sent notice that it would hold a workshop on May 10th. Topics include community housing and the Community Preservation Act.

PRESENT BUSINESS:

78 Elm Street: Chair Lantry was pleased to report that Ron Koiview had sold the property to an owner who was apparently interested in restoring the house and barn. Taner Cole was still interested in moving the barn to his Christmas tree farm on Howard street, assuming it was to be torn down. The commission agreed to make efforts to find another historic barn for Mr. Cole.

May 4th town meeting: at the recent town meeting, voters once again denied permission for the Select Board to sell the Old Primary School and Brooks house properties. Funding for engineering regarding converting the T C Passios building to town offices was approved. Lakso presented article 39, which requested permanent easement for parking at the Historical Society, and the voters approved the article.
